Harmony for Habitat

Pine Island, FL; June 18, 2008 – On Tuesday, June 24th, a bevy of local bands and artists will jam out for charity at the Harmony for Habitat fundraiser, including Kip Lawrence and Jim Morris. The money raised will go towards Pine Island's second home currently being built. Plus, attendees can expect great food and a silent auction, featuring guided fishing trips, a wine tasting party, a weekend at Tarpon Lodge and Miracle Baseball Tickets. Harmony for Habitat will take place at Woody's Waterside Restaurant at 3051 Stringfellow Road in St. James City. Doors open for the five hour charity event at 4 p.m.

Harmony for Habitat is part of an ongoing effort to fundraise for the \$50,000 sponsorship of the second home. Other fundraisers for the sponsorship include selling pavers for the landscaping project at Woody's Waterside Restaurant and selling paper Habitat homes at the Winn Dixie Supermarket and local banks.

Habitat for Humanity of Lee County is a non-profit organization dedicated to eliminating substandard housing in Lee County. So far, Habitat has built more than 900 homes in Lee County since 1982. Through the use of volunteer labor and donations of money and materials, Habitat builds simple, decent housing for families who otherwise could not afford it. **Homes are sold to the homeowners at no profit on an interest-free mortgage**, making homeownership an affordable reality.
