Miromar Lakes Plays Golf Holes for a House

Miromar Lakes, FL; May 12, 2008 – The Miromar Lakes Community hit a hole in one with its golf tournament and fundraiser on April 26th. The community raised enough money through the event to sponsor a Habitat home in Lee County. The tournament included an 18-hole event at the Miromar Lakes Golf Club, a Texas barbeque supper and a silent and live auction. Tournament attendees also had a chance to win a new car from Estero Bay Chevrolet with a hole in one on the first par three. In all, the community brought in more than \$52,000 to go toward building an affordable, safe and decent home for a deserving Lee County family. The Miromar Lakes Community raised the walls on their first sponsored home with Habitat on March 11th in Fort Myers.

Habitat for Humanity of Lee County is a non-profit organization dedicated to eliminating substandard housing in Lee County. So far, Habitat has built more than 900 homes in Lee County since 1982. Through the use of volunteer labor and donations of money and materials, Habitat builds simple, decent housing for families who otherwise could not afford it. **Homes are sold to the homeowners at no profit on an interest-free mortgage**, making homeownership an affordable reality.
