Pelican Landing Raises Habitat's Roof

Bonita Springs, FL; November 7, 2009 – Join **Habitat for Humanity** and **Pelican Landing residents** as we raise a roof at **9966 Alabama Street at 8am on Saturday, November 7th**. The Pelican Landing Community has contributed over \$340,000 to Habitat for Humanity of Lee County over the last six years. With those donations, the group has raised seven homes in Lee County.

Mariela Carrillo, 20 and Jose Rangel, 21 will be on site for the raising of their Habitat home. The couple has two daughters; Madeline, 1 and Melanie, 2. Mariela works at Publix Supermarkets in Customer Service and Jose works Swartz Electric as an electrician.

Habitat for Humanity of Lee County is a non-profit organization dedicated to eliminating substandard housing in the community. Since 1982, the affiliate has provided 1000 families a safe and affordable place to live. Through the use of volunteer labor and donations of money and materials, Habitat builds simple, decent housing for families who otherwise could not afford it. **Homes are sold to the homeowners at no profit on an interest-free mortgage**, making homeownership an affordable reality.
